By Bus:

From the CBD to UQ Lakes Busway: 109

From CBD to Chancellors Place Station: 411 & 412

By Ferry (City Cat): The UQ City Cat stop is the last stop on the route. City Cat terminal is near the corner of Sir William McGregor Drive and Blair Drive. From the Ferry, walk across Sir William McGregor Dr up to Blair Dr. Pass the pool on the left, continue to walk uphill (Union Rd) towards the Union Complex). Continue across courtyard (end of Campbell Place) to the Steele Building.

By Bicycle:

Cycle from the West via the bike-path parallel to Sir Fred Schonell Drive until Sir William McGregor Drive (at the roundabout). Turn right at roundabout, then left at the next roundabout to enter Campbell Rd and follow to the end. You will reach Campbell Place, with the Steele Building on the other side).

Cycle from the East across the Eleanour Schonell Bridge from Dutton Park, go uphill past the Union Complex to reach the Steele Building. Bike Parking is available in most areas.

By Car:

Driving along Coronation Drive away from the city – until it becomes Sir Fred Schonell Drive. Continue though two roundabouts (2nd roundabout intersects Sir William McGregor Drive) (note: Sir Fred Schonell Drive turns into **Campbell Rd**) Continue short distance to another roundabout, turning **LEFT** onto Blair Drive. Take next **RIGHT** onto Union Rd. Park in the open-air parking lot immediately left, or below UQ Centre (Bldg 27A) (entrance on left as soon as you enter Union Rd). Both are paid parking areas; obtain ticket at "Pay & Display" ticket machine.
