

Scheme of amalgamation between the Queensland Public Sector Union of Employees and the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union, Central and Southern Queensland Clerical and Administrative Branch, Union of Employees

General nature of Amalgamation

1. The proposed amalgamation is an amalgamation between the Queensland Public Sector Union of Employees (“the QPSU”), and the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union, Central and Southern Queensland Clerical and Administrative Branch, Union of Employees (“the AMACSU).
2. The AMACSU is the proposed amalgamated organisation.
3. For the purpose of the amalgamation the QPSU is proposed to be deregistered.

Members of the proposed deregistering organisation become members of the amalgamated organisation without payment of an entrance fee

4. All members of the QPSU are to become, on amalgamation, without payment of an entrance fee, members of the AMACSU.

Change to the name of the proposed amalgamated organisation

5. The name of AMACSU is to be changed to Unite Queensland, Industrial Union of Employees.

No amendments to the eligibility rule

6. It is not proposed to amend the eligibility Rules of the existing registered organisations.

Amendments to the rules

7. A new set of Rules for the amalgamated organisation is to be adopted.

Property

8. On the Amalgamation Day all assets of the QPSU shall cease to be assets of that organisation and become assets of the proposed amalgamated organisation.
9. For all purposes and all proceedings the assets of the QPSU existing immediately before the Amalgamation Day are taken to have become the assets of the proposed amalgamated organisation on that day.

Liabilities

10. On the Amalgamation Day all liabilities of the QPSU shall cease to be liabilities of that organisation and become liabilities of the proposed amalgamated organisation.
11. For all purposes and all proceedings a liability of the QPSU existing immediately before the Amalgamation Day is taken to have become a liability of the proposed amalgamated organisation on that day.
